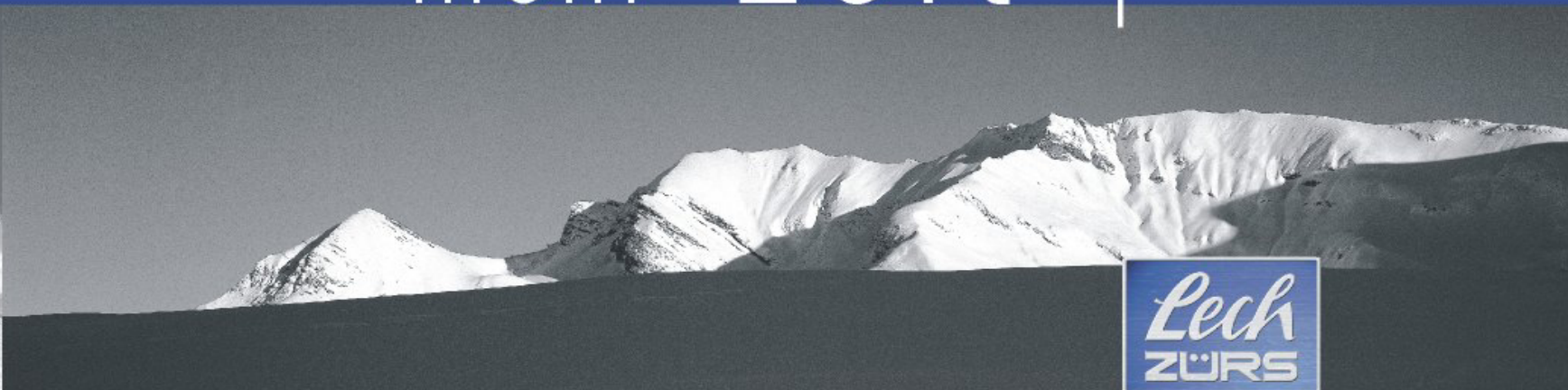

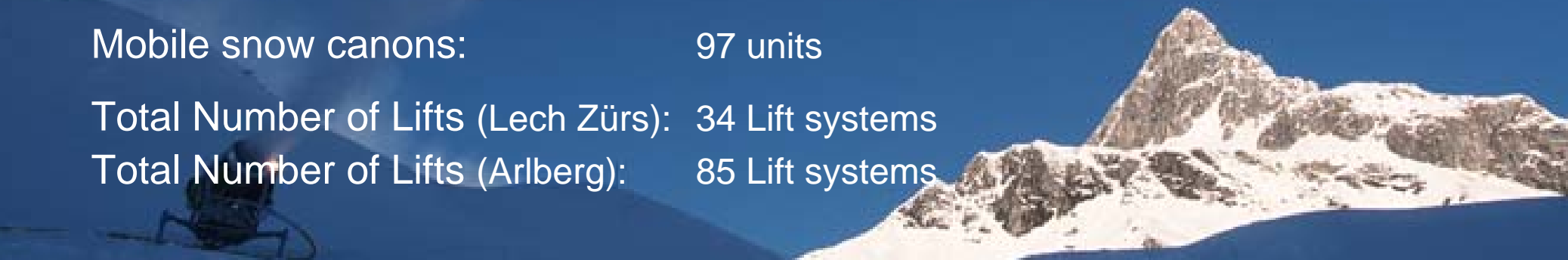

The demonstration slope will be prepared by artificial snow and locked off for several ski races if necessary.

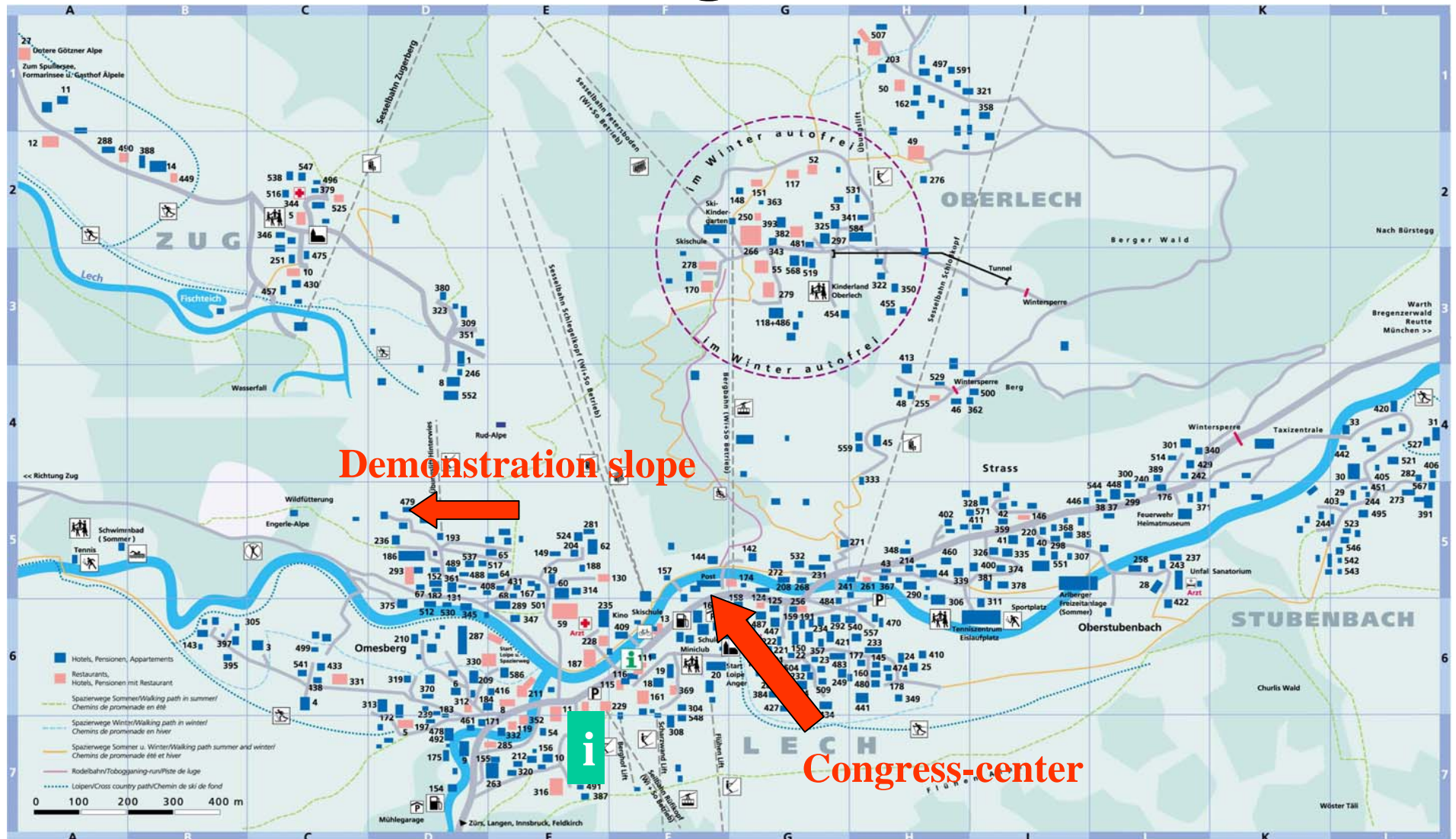

Lech and Zürs „the event-place with short ways“

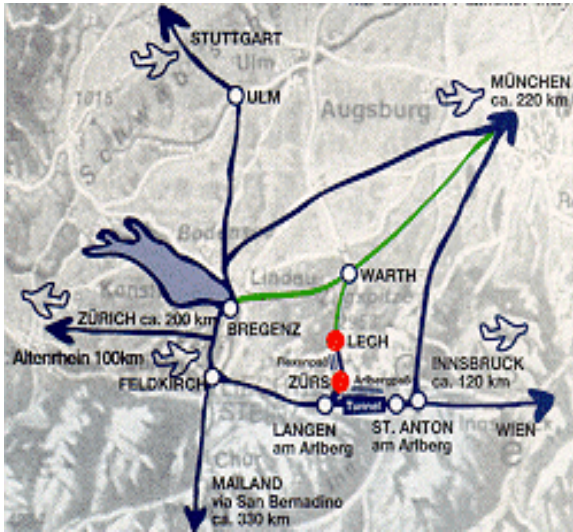
- In Lech and Zürs the ways are short and the binding between the different local parts are very good
- The cable car „Lech-Oberlech“ leaves every 15 minutes (07:00 – 01:00)
- The local bus is included in the skipass and leaves every 15-20 minutes (7.00 – 19.00 o'clock) to the different parts of Lech and in the night the night bus „James“ leaves every 30 minutes (19:30 – 3:15)
- The demonstration slope is situated very central and can be reached by feet or by skis.
- The meeting-area is also situated in the center, has a capacity of 300 people and has the infrastructure which is necessary.

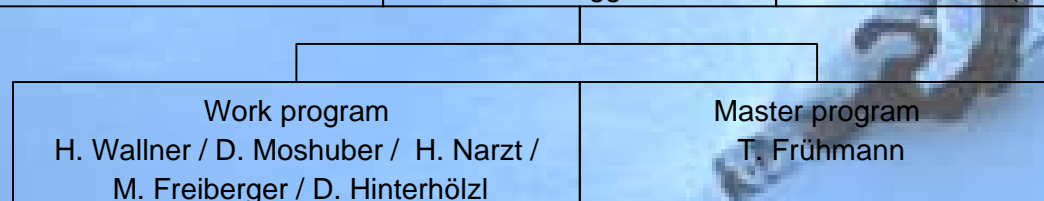
